

Items which **Cannot** be accepted for the SSUC Garage Sale

We cannot accept anything that is broken or damaged or missing parts such as power cords and battery powered items missing batteries or with dead batteries.

Anything that is extremely heavy and awkward to handle.

- Art – no pieces with broken glass or broken frames
- Art – large pieces sell well; posters and prints are difficult to move
- Attic Treasures – no silver plate; nothing chipped, cracked or broken
- Bath, Laundry and Personal Care – no personal care items open or used – no rollers, straighteners, manicure sets, curling irons, razors, soaps, etc.; no used foot baths or similar
- Books – check with Bonnie Berg re what is acceptable for the sale
- Attic Treasures – nothing that is chipped, cracked or broken
- Children’s and Toys – no Barbie or Barbie clothes, nothing broken, dirty or missing parts; no auto or bike child seats or trailers
- Christmas and Seasonal – artificial trees only if complete and boxed
- Clothing and Jewelry – only women’s clothes (on hangers, please)
- Crafts and Baskets – no small or midsize baskets; can use large baskets for display purposes
- Crafts and Patterns – no sewing patterns
- Crafts Supplies – only new or unused craft supplies
- Crafts Completed – no, difficult to sell
- Décor – small ornaments and knickknacks do not sell; no floral shop vases or bowls; no used candles of any size
- Electronics – no computers nor any electronic device not working or missing parts
- Electronics – no CRT televisions
- Food – no food items of any kind (coffee, teas, spices or seasonings, mixes, oils, etc.)

Items which **Cannot** be accepted for the SSUC Garage Sale

- Furniture - nothing heavy that cannot be carried up four flights. No particle board, e.g., IKEA which is heavy and can be difficult to take apart or reassemble. No upholstered or worn leather furniture or office chairs.
- Games and Puzzles – nothing with missing parts or pieces
- Gardening and Outdoor - no nursery planters or dirty pots or rusted, broken or weathered items and no dirty or broken outdoor furniture – nothing missing parts
- Hardware/Tools – nothing broken, rusted or missing parts
- Kitchen – no partial dish or glass sets; dirty or broken plastic containers; nothing chipped, cracked or broken
- Linens – nothing dirty or torn. Worn linens or towels are best taken to a vet clinic or animal shelter
- Linens – no blinds, curtains and drapes as they are difficult to sell
- Linens – no mattresses or pillows or duvets
- Luggage, handbags, wallets, garment bags – nothing torn or excessively worn or dirty
- Music/Video – no cassettes
- Office – no binders of any size; no loose papers, partial notepads; loose greeting cards, etc.
- Photo Frames – small or mid-sized frames do not sell; please no broken frames or frames missing glass
- Small Appliances – no if missing parts or cords. Rug shampooers do not sell.
- Sports/Pets – no exercise equipment as it is usually heavy and generally does not sell
- Sports/Pets – no skis, no dirty or torn hockey bags or old and worn hockey equipment, no broken or dirty camping gear or gear with missing parts
- Tires – awkward, heavy and hard to display but check with David/Sandra
