We are so grateful for your part in all this and more. We can't say **thank you** enough!

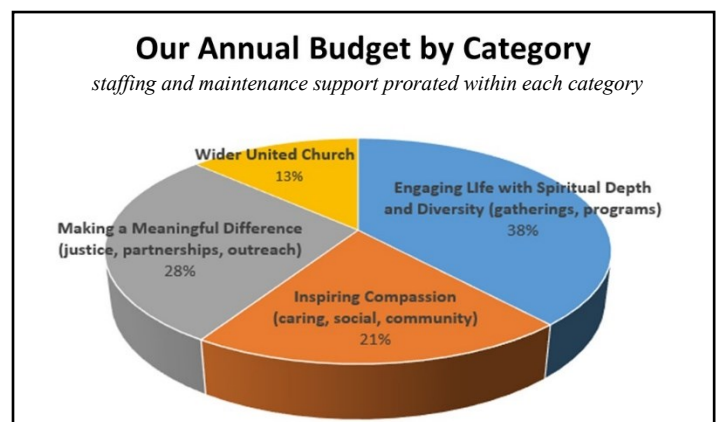
Perhaps we all agree that the work we do and the expansive, inclusive presence of SSUC is vital to our lives, and to the world! And we have plans for the coming year – **2024 will be exciting!**

- We'll be committing to our vision with some new staff to lead us in particular areas of 2SLGBTQIA+ support and programming, and in developing multi-generational events and meaningful age-based programs
- We'll continue cultivating and strengthening relationships with local Indigenous communities and issues;
- We'll celebrate our 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary as the first Albertan Affirming ministry in the United Church of Canada!

**All of this** requires **all of us** in support! Initial estimates predict that our total ministry in 2024 will require many volunteer hours and close to \$500,000.

Through the month of November, we'd like to encourage you to continue your spiritual practice of generosity as we invite you to consider how you can support and donate to SSUC with your time, your talent, and your finances in the coming year.

As part of the SSUC community, we'd like you to consider helping in these ways:

1. Complete a **Financial Donor Pledge Form**, which helps us know your donation intentions. It's our best way of shaping an accurate budget to be presented to the Annual General Meeting in March 2024. To help and encourage you, we've included a Step Chart showing the number of donors on each giving step. After you identify your current level of giving on the **Step Chart**, we invite you to consider "stepping up" one or more levels in your giving to help us all achieve our community's goals.

Perhaps this is also the time, if you don't already, to choose to start giving monthly. Regular consistent giving is easy through the **Pre-Authorized Remittance (PAR)** program, and is a huge help to our ability to do the work of our congregation consistently and well. A PAR form is included to help you sign up or change the amount you'd like to give in the months ahead. We are also available to help with any questions you may have about PAR.

2. Because we all give with our volunteer time as well, we'd invite you to complete a **Time and Task Pledge Form**, offering specific ways you might contribute your energy and abilities to help your SSUC community. We want you to contribute in ways that will bring you fulfillment and deepen your connections with what's important in life, and with other folks in your SSUC community.
3. Attend or tune-in to any of our four Sunday gatherings in November, when we'll hear from various people within the SSUC community and what makes their giving journey so important to them. Let's inspire one another with our stories!
