It's important to celebrate what we accomplished together in 2025. Just a few highlights:

- In providing livestreamed gatherings and online programs, we engaged with new folks, growing connections and deepening the reach of our unique and needed expression of expansive spirituality.
- In the first year of our YOUTHSPACE and Evergreens Community GSA, both of these programs have grown and deepened, Evergreens starting with just 3 youth a year ago expanding to over 20 and growing!
- The inherit generosity of SSUC is not restricted to our budgeted Outreach
 programs that support agencies in Edmonton and Saskatoon, it was apparent in
 the multiple donations of underwear and winter socks, and Christmas toys to
 furnish human dignity, advocacy for peace and justice, work in the areas of
 Livable Income, the expansion of our Food Bank Depot to accommodate more
 households in SW Edmonton challenged with food insecurity, and so much
 more.
- We helped mark milestones and important life transitions in so many lives, experiencing joyous welcomes, grieving losses, celebrating anniversaries, and everything in between. In all of it, expressing connection, care and meaning.

We couldn't have accomplished all we did in 2025 without your support and generosity. We share deep gratitude for your part – big or small!



Let's begin to ponder what possibilities lie before us in 2026. It's exciting to think of the opportunities already before us – Yes, there's always more work to do, and many of you are part of plans already underway:

- We are recognizing food insecurity means more than a food hamper; it's often accompanied by learning new skills and building resilience. Work has begun to examine our role in providing leadership and space for a community kitchen where folks can learn shopping and cooking skills.
- We've noticed a need among those with mobility challenges, disability, and chronic pain for physical activity and movement programs in a safe, cost-barrier-free and inclusive environment. Exploration and funding are being sought to offer a weekly chair yoga program to meet this need.

What's new for children and families? How about our engagement with our Earth Charter commitments? What will our advocacy and affirmation look like in the political and economic climate of 2026? What support and exploration groups might help us connect, find meaning and do good? These are up to all of us!


